Prior to joining Kay Casto & Chaney, Bob Rodecker was a solo practitioner with a primary emphasis on representing clients before the Public Service Commission. Mr. Rodecker previously served as a staff attorney for the Appalachian Research and Defense Fund, Inc. and later for the Public Service Commission of West Virginia.
